Brother Marv began life in Manistee County, the son of Reino G. and Hilda E. (Kaudy) Lagerquist. He attended Norman Dickson High School. Marv resides in Brethren, MI with his wife Iola whom he married on May 4, 1957. They are the proud parents of two daughters, Tina and Toni and a son Todd. His family has given Marv and Iola seven wonderful grandchildren, three girls and four boys. Marv retired from the Packaging Corporation of America after 37-1/2 years where he was in management as a scheduling and shipping supervisor. He and Iola are members of the Epworth United Methodist Church in Brethren.

In 1963, Brother Marv petitioned Onekama Lodge #497, F&AM and was raised a Master Mason on October 28, 1963. At the 1963 annual meeting, he was elected to the office of Junior Deacon and thus began his journey through the chairs to the East. He served his Lodge with dignity and fairness as Worshipful Master in 1968 and again in 1991, 1994 and 1997.

Our Brother decided he wanted "more light in Masonry" so in the Spring of 1967, he petitioned the Valley of Grand Rapids and on May 4-5, he became a "Sublime Prince of the Royal Secret." He immediately became active in the Valley.

For his work and devotion to Scottish Rite Masonry, Brother Marv has received the Loyal Service Award from the Valley of Grand Rapids. In 1990 at the Supreme Council Session in Milwaukee, he was awarded the 33°.

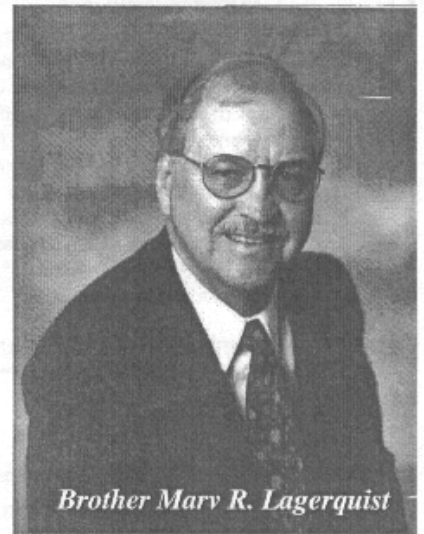
Brother Lagerquist, a plural member of the Valley of Traverse City, is also very active with us and continues to serve both Valleys with dignity and honor!
